- In what way is our righteousness to exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees???

Matt. 5:20

Traditional Interpretation of the sixth commandment (on murder)

- Spoken by the elders

Matt 15:2

Jesus said:

“you have heard”

“it was said”

All referring to: ORAL TRADITIONS

Scribes and Pharisees Interpretation

“whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment”

Matt. 5:21

Likely referring to the LOCAL COURTS at the time.

This may sound fine
But it did not go far enough!!!

Teaching of Jesus

Murder is WRONG

EMOTIONS that build up to murder is WRONG.

Matt. 5:22

Notice:

Proverbs 6:16-19

compare back to **Matt. 5:17**

The Law should have been applied in this fashion.

Teaching of Jesus cont.

Angry without cause: Danger of
Judgment

Says Raca to brother: Danger of Council
Or blockhead

Says “You Fool”:
Danger of Hell-fire

Do something about your emotions

**If your emotions are not
under control,
Destruction will come**

Mark 9:43-48

Righteousness of the kingdom

The scribes and Pharisees only went so far.

Jesus' teachings are in harmony with his
Fathers word and the Law.

Galations 5:19-23

Jesus continues to emphasize

Emotions affect our relationships with
God and men.

Matt. 5:23-24

Therefore do something about it.

1 John 4:20-21

Quickly make amends

Matt. 5:25-26

Don't be a: **“HOT-HEAD,”**

and

let your anger go Out Of Control,

and

you do something to be in

DANGER OF

HELL-FIRE

Matt. 7:21-23
